ATTENTION: SPRING PICNIC CHANGE

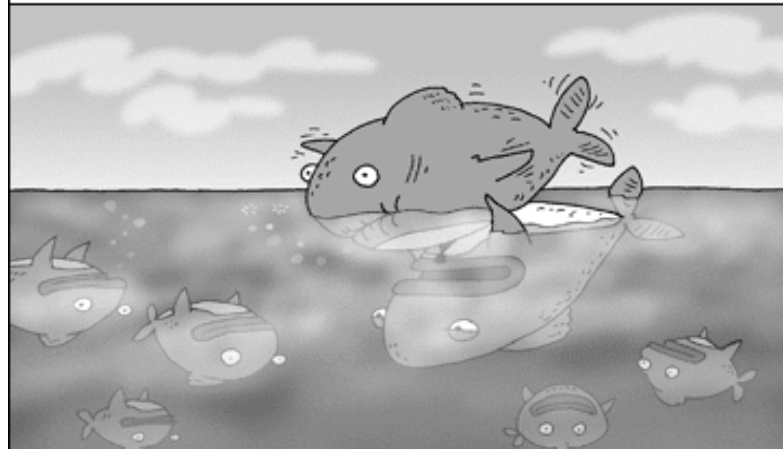
