

Evidence of Effectiveness Report

Union Bible College is fulfilling its mission of being an institution of higher education, which “is committed to the propagation of scriptural holiness and the preparation of servant leaders who change the world with the unchanging Word.” This evidence is demonstrated in the following ways:

1. Union Bible College develops the spiritual, physical, intellectual, emotional, and social dimensions of the students. The Wesley Wellness Profile from Spring 2021 indicates a spiritual index for our students of 93%. 97.7% of our students indicated that they have personally chosen to serve the Lord, 99% are committed to live by God’s Word, and 98.3% are committed to the Bible as the inspired Word of God.
2. Academic programs at UBC prepare students for life in accordance with God’s calling. 80% of the 2021 seniors reported that UBC prepared them for ministry and 90% reported that their Christian worldview developed during their time at UBC.
3. The 2021 Senior Theology Content Exam for Theology of Holiness was 88.3%. In the 2021 Wesley Wellness Profile 93.2% of the students reported that they believe God can make a person’s heart pure.
4. For the past 25 years, 81% of UBC’s students who graduated with a BA degree are in ministries related to their area of study and in 2021, 80% of our graduates reported that their program of study has prepared them for ministry.
5. The opportunity to participate in relevant field experiences applicable to their programs is evidenced by 82% of the 2021 graduates reporting the experiences were adequate.
6. An understanding of a diversity of worldviews as a foundation to determine the superiority of the Christian worldview is demonstrated by 90% of the 2021 seniors reporting that their Christian worldview developed during their time at UBC.
7. An engagement in critical, analytical thinking that will enable the student to make careful assessments and draw clear conclusions is demonstrated by our students scoring 115.2 on the critical thinking skills subset of the ETS Proficiency Profile Test given in spring of 2019. This was 4.04% higher than the national norm for this area of critical thinking. The 2021 graduates survey revealed 84% of our graduates reporting their critical thinking skills improved.
8. The culture of effectiveness in reaching the goal of excellence in all things is demonstrated by the Total Weighted Financial Score being 2.5 for 2020. The 2020 Faculty/Staff Perceptions Survey demonstrated 97% of the faculty and staff reported that their program fulfills at least one of the institutional goals.
9. A Christian model of servant leadership is demonstrated at UBC by 89% of the students reporting that the instructors modeled appropriate morals and ethics.
10. Institutional consistency in all facets of operation and communication is exhibited by 100% of the Board members reporting the UBC president provides his briefings to them in a succinct, efficient manner. 87% of our students indicated if they had it to do over, they would enroll at UBC again.
