

UBCA COVID-19 Response Statement

Union Bible College and Academy is committed to the health and well-being of our students, faculty, and staff. We whole-heartedly believe an on-campus learning experience contributes to that well-being. Therefore, we are taking the following precautions to ensure UBCA can return to the greatest sense of normalcy on our campus for the fall 2020 semester. The UBCA community will:

- Encourage carefulness within social distancing in all areas of campus
- Enhance personal hygiene efforts
 - Encourage frequent handwashing
 - Enhance accessibility to hand sanitizing stations
 - Educate and promote
- Enhance cleaning and disinfecting measures
 - Disinfect heavily trafficked areas regularly
 - Clean and disinfect all personal areas regularly
 - Clean and disinfect dorm common areas regularly
- Extend excused absences to any student unable to be in classes due to COVID-19
 - If a student has COVID like symptoms of any sort, they are to stay home. They will be excused from class.
 - For the absence to be excused, they need to contact the registrar, academic secretary, or VP of Academic Affairs.
 - Constant request for absence with COVID symptoms will necessitate the student moving off-campus and completing the classes online.
- Make online learning opportunities available to any student diagnosed with COVID-19
- Provide a controlled quarantine area for any dorm student infected by COVID-19. The ladies' dorm guest room #3 will be designated as a quarantine
- Require any student, faculty, or staff displaying two or more of the following symptoms to stay home:
 - Fever and chills (greater than 100.4)
 - Cough
 - Shortness of breath or difficulty breathing
 - Muscle or body aches
 - New loss of taste or smell
- Require quarantine of 14 days for any student, faculty, or staff testing positive for COVID-19
- **For Faculty only, online learning is optional for students.**
 - Students fearful of attending college due to the COVID-19 crisis will be allowed to take classes online.
 - These students are not allowed to live in the dorm but must stay home.
 - All faculty must make their classes available to any online student that would normally be in their class. This includes either recording a video of class, providing a PowerPoint lecture, or a manuscript of lecturer available on Populi.

We trust these precautions will enhance our on-campus experience for the fall semester. Union Bible College and Academy is committed to preparing the next generation of World Changers. We trust the 2020-2021 school year will be the greatest to date and look forward to facilitating a quality Christian education for our students.
